Winter Rules

- Tobogganing is permitted in designated areas only.
- When tobogganing: make sure the route is clear before proceeding, always face forward, clear the path quickly after stopping, avoid excessive speeding and **DO NOT** alter the hill.
- All users must act in a safe & responsible manner.
- The ABRA does not provide supervision for rink/toboggan hill use.
- Members and guests will enter and use the outdoor amenities at their own risk.
- The ABRA staff will evict any user displaying unacceptable behavior of any kind
- Helmets are highly recommended for anyone who is skating or using the toboggan hill.
- Nobody is allowed on a skating surface while the Zamboni or other equipment is servicing it.
- Hockey sticks and pucks are not permitted on the pleasure rink.
- ABRA residents and their guests are expected to respect the private rinks of Lake Shore residents.
- General courtesy is expected of all individuals using any skating or tobogganing area in the park.
- No person is permitted on the ice while Thin Ice signs are up.
- No person shall dispose of any debris, including but not limited to rocks, trash, sticks and ice chunks onto the ice.
- Ice fishing holes must be made by an ice auger and no larger than 8 inches in diameter.
- Ice fishing holes may not be drilled any closer than 20 feet of ANY prepared ice surface.
