Junior Counselors will also be required to attend First Aid and Safety Training in the first week of May 2019 (exact date(s) TBD).

Requirements/ Expectations:

- Executing camp activities in an engaging manner
- Leading and participating in activities with the children
- Communicating with parents before and after camp
- Ensuring a safe camp environment
- Providing attentive supervision and guidance for campers
- Adapting activities when needed
- Acting as a role-model to the children
- First aid certification is an asset; however, all staff will be provided with this certification
- It is a requirement for all counselors to submit a satisfactory Criminal Background Check
- Counselors must have graduated from high school

Additional Camp Information:

We have 8 weeks of themed camps that generally run for ages 3-5 and ages 6-12. We will be doing a variety of crafts and fun activities that relate to the theme of each week. Camp activities run 9am- 4pm each day and we also provide pre/post camp care to campers.
