Scuba Diving Rules

- Members may bring in guests to scuba dive providing that all divers are open water certified.
- All divers must show their certification cards before entering the park with their dive gear.
- All divers must dive with a certified buddy. There must always be at least two (2) divers in the water.
- Divers must use a flag so that swimmers and boaters will know where the divers are.
- Vehicles may enter the Boat Launch area when loading or unloading equipment, but they must never be parked or left unattended there. Vehicles must be parked either on the road or in the Parking Lot.
- Divers must sign in and sign out at the Administration Office. They will be asked to sign a release of liability waiver.
